Dr.Pethuru Raj shared his experience where ever required and sighted real time challenges faced in Wipro when 60 companies that where found to be under utilized in Wipro that where networked together to form Wipros first Private cloud exclusively for Wipro employees.

Dr.Pethuru Raj also gave an insight into the Code Development aspects future trends where he talked about how UML Models could be transfered into 85 percent of program codes and the only

remaining 15 percent requires that of human intervention and how modules that could take 3 to 6 months to complete in the past has shrunk to 5 - 10 minutes of work.

In the afternoon session, a Demonstration of Mobile Cloud was given by Mr.Gajendran Ganesapandian, Subject Matter Expert, Ebay – Paypal India Development Center, Chennai. Faculty members, research scholars and students from various colleges participated.
