Editorial

Cloud Computing

Cloud computing technology has been a new buzzword in the IT industry and expecting a new horizon for coming world. It is a style of computing which is having dynamically scalable virtualized resources provided as a service over the Internet. It reduces the time required to procure heavy resources and boot new server instances in minutes, allowing one to quickly scale capacity, both up and down, as ones requirement changes. Nevertheless the technology is hot in the market and is ready to cater to the small and medium business segment.

Cloud computing is emerging at the convergence of three major trends — service orientation, virtualization and standardization of computing through the Internet. Cloud computing enables users and developers to utilize services without knowledge of, expertise with, nor control over the technology infrastructure that supports them. The concept generally incorporates combinations of - Infrastructure as a service (IaaS), Platform as a service (PaaS), and Software as a service (SaaS).

Cloud computing customers do not generally own the physical infrastructure serving as host to the software platform in question. Instead, they avoid capital expenditure by renting usage from a third-party provider. The entire onus lies on the service provider who owns the huge scalable and variable host of infrastructure, software and bundle of other services. Cloud computing consumers consume resources as a service and pay only for resources that they use. Many cloud-computing offerings employ the utility computing model, which is analogous to how traditional utility services (such as electricity) are consumed, while others bill on a subscription basis. Sharing "perishable and intangible" computing power among multiple tenants can improve utilization rates, as servers are not unnecessarily left idle (which can reduce costs significantly while increasing the speed of application development).

While there are benefits, there are privacy and security concerns too. Data is travelling over the Internet and is stored in remote locations. In addition, cloud providers often serve multiple customers simultaneously. All of this may raise the scale of exposure to possible breaches, both accidental and deliberate.

Events conducted at IE Building, Bharath Heavy Electricals Ltd.(BHEL)

A lecture programme was arranged on the topic 'IP Telephony and its Features' on 13th August 2013 in the Institution of Engineers (IE) Building, BHEL. Shri A. Kalai Selvan, Sr. Engineer, Informatics Centre, BHEL, Tiruchirappalli spoke on the topic. In his talk, he explained the basics of IP Telephony and the some voice parameters for implementing IP telephony. He also discussed about the trends in enterprise IP telephony, protocols that provide VoIP communication services, and quality of service. He also touched upon the benefits of IP telephony implementation from the customer, maintenance team and management perspectives.
